Assessment & Consultation Fees

Psychiatrist Consultation

- Although we endeavour to notify every patient as soon as their referral expires. It is ultimately the patient's responsibility to ensure that their referral is current, and their responsibility to obtain a new one from their GP. Referrals from GPs are valid for 12 months.
- Without a valid referral you will not be eligible for any Medicare rebates. This also applies to Bulk Billed, DVA and State based workers compensation claims. Without this GP referral you will be charged full fee (Out of Pocket) No rebate.
- Pre-payment is required for all initial appointments. A \$350 deposit must be paid to secure initial consultations.
- 1.5% card processing fee applies on all transactions.
- **Please note** our doctors **do not bulk bill** and we **do not accept 291 referrals** for ADHD assessment or management.
- **Fast Track Package** appointments are available for patients requiring **urgent consultations**. Please contact the Practice Manager directly to arrange, noting that additional fees apply.
- Urgent Same Day Script (Existing patients only) – A fixed fee of \$75 (no GST) applies if a review appointment has been missed or cancelled.
- Urgent appointment same day (Existing patients only) - \$350 (no GST) for 30 minutes (GAP Fee/No rebate).
- Please note: All reports are privately billed, with fees varying depending on the time required and the complexity of the report. These services are not eligible for Medicare rebates. Full payment is required prior to the release of any report.
- Payment plan policy: Please note that total amount of payments under a payment plan are limited to \$600 only (Excluding ADHD/ASD assessments)

- Cancellations: Our cancellation policy requires at least 7 business days notice. If you cancel on the same day of the appointment or do not attend a cancellation of \$100 applies.
- Medicare rebate is automatically processed within 48 business hours from our end.
- Rural or remote patients will only incur the assessment fee and a discounted gap fee for specific conditions.

4. Other Clinical Conditions

Our fees may vary depending on the complexity of clinical conditions including mood disorders, anxiety disorders, eating disorders, addiction disorders, dementia assessment and DVA/work injury assessment. The following tables are intended as a general guide only. Please check with our Practice Manager for confirmation of applicable fees prior to your appointment.

5. Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS)

| TMS Motor Threshold Mapping | One-time calibration to personalise stimulation intensity | 30–45 min | \$300 | \$158.45 |
| Standard TMS Session- delivered by Dr Krishnaiah and trained technician under direct supervision | 1 session | 40 min | \$220 | \$152.45 |

Note: Medicare may provide [rebates for TMS](#) treatment depending on eligibility. Some private health insurers may provide partial rebates. Check with your provider. Payment is required upfront for packages or prior to individual sessions.

6. Psychiatric Reports

Our psychiatrist can provide a range of formal psychiatric reports, including:

- NDIS & DSP Reports
- Legal & Insurance Reports...
- Employer & University Reports
- Fitness to drive Assessments
- Cosmetic Surgery Clearance- Consultation fee (\$850) and report fee (\$850 plus gst) are not Medicare rebated
- Superannuation Early Release
- Weapons licencing

Note: All reports are privately billed. Fees vary depending on time taken to review materials, assessments and complexity. These services are not eligible for Medicare rebates.

7. Concession Card Holder

- A discount may be applied to consultation fees at the discretion of the provider for valid concession card holders. Concession must be presented at the time of booking and on the day of service.

8. Cancellation & Attendance Policy

- Appointments require **advance notice** for cancellation or rescheduling.
- Non-attendance, late cancellations, or unpaid fees may result in a **cancellation fee of \$100**
- Your cooperation ensures appointments can be offered to others in need.
